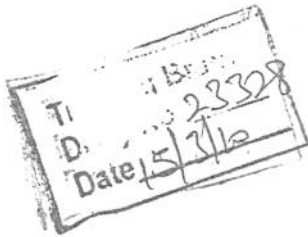

Subject : SIDA's International Training programme on "Copyright and Related Rights in the Global Economy", to be held in Stockholm, Sweden, from September 27 to October 15, 2010 and a regional follow-up conducted in March 7 to 11, 2011. – Nomination regarding.

The Embassy of Sweden has invited the nominations for the above-mentioned training course to be held in Stockholm, Sweden.

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The programme is for policy-makers and their advisers as well as towards persons at a senior decision-making level from the government sector, collective management organizations and also to persons from the university or the private sector who are or who will be involved in issues concerning copyrights and related rights. There is no specific slot for India. The Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (SIDA) provides funds to the selected Indian participants, covering training fees, board and lodging. "International travel cost (air tickets) to and from Sweden will also be covered by SIDA. The participants carries costs incurred in traveling to the nearest international airport as well as visa costs."

The nominations of suitable candidates may be done in accordance with Department of Economic Affairs O.M. No. 1/13/03-PMU dated 5.4.2004 (Copy enclosed). The nomination details should be submitted on the following :

Subject : A Group Training Course in technical Support for SME Promotion (Organic Materials/Inorganic Materials and Metals) to be held in Japan from 16/8/2010 to 27/11/2010 (Core Phase).

The undersigned is directed to state that the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA), under the Technical Cooperation Programme of the Government of Japan has invited applications for the above programme. The total duration of the programme is from July 2010 to May 2011, out of this, the Core Phase, from 16/8/2010 to 27/11/2010 will be held in Japan. The Preliminary Phase and the Finalization Phase will be held in the candidate's home country. The details of the programme and the application form may be drawn from Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions website (persmin.nic.in).

2. The Program is designed for National/Local Government bodies dealing with technical support for SME. The Course aims to disseminate the knowledge and technology supporting small and medium enterprises (SME) in organic chemical industry/inorganic chemical and metal industries among researchers and engineers in the participating organization.

3. The Candidates should be engaged in work or research related to SME Promotion in the field of organic materials/inorganic materials & metals having more than 3 years' experience; be graduate of university and have majored in organic chemistry/ inorganic chemistry and metal or the equivalent; be proficient at written and spoken English; be between twenty five and forty five years of age; be in good health, both physically and mentally to undergo the training and not be serving in the military.

4. The fellowship award covers the cost of a Round-trip air ticket between an international airport designated by the JICA and Japan; travel insurance from the time of arrival in Japan to departure from Japan; allowances for (accommodation, living expenses, outfit and shipping); expenses for JICA study tours and free medical care for participants who may fall ill after reaching Japan. The participants are not allowed to take any family member during the training course.

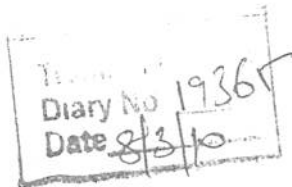

6. The nomination details should be submitted in the JICA's prescribed proformas (A2A3 Forms), duly authenticated by the Department concerned alongwith the country report.

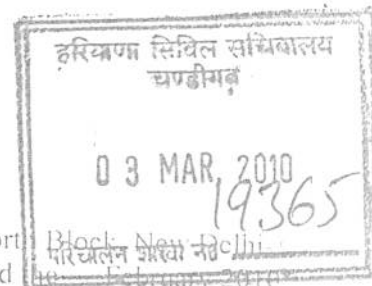

Subject: Master in Public Management (MPM) 2011 Programme being conducted by Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy, National University of Singapore

The undersigned is directed to state that the Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy (LKYSPP), National University of Singapore is organizing a one-year Master in Public Management (MPM) 2011 programme from January, 2011 to December 2011. The details of the programme and the application forms may be drawn from Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions website (persmin.nic.in).

2. The MPM programme is a one year programme for senior executives in the public and private sectors who have a proven track record of leadership within their organizations. It is designed to intellectually reinvigorate and equip the qualifying candidates with the latest thinking and best practices in public policy. The programme also offers candidates a unique opportunity to spend a semester at the John F Kennedy School of Government (KSG), Harvard University or at the School of International and Public Affairs (SIPA), Columbia University

3. The candidates should be between 35 to 50 years old; have a minimum of eight to ten years working experience preferably in the area of policy making and public management and have a good command of the English language

4. Scholarships are being offered on a competitive basis for the applicants who have demonstrated exceptional leadership qualities and are committed to public service. The scholarships includes a monthly stipend throughout the period of award; one-time book allowance; one-time settling-in allowance; shared housing; tuition, health insurance, examination and other approved fees; Tuition fees and accommodation at partner university; Cost of travel from home country to Singapore on award of the Fellowship; Cost of travel from Singapore to partner University; Cost of travel from partner university to Singapore; Cost of travel from Singapore to home country on graduation.
