Subject: Reduction in telephone bills of the Government

Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention to the subject cited above and to say that the State Government Departments, Boards, Corporations and other statutory bodies are presently using fixed landline telephone both at the offices and residences of the officers/officials as well as mobile telephone service on Bharat Sanchar Nigam Ltd. (BSNL). In its endeavor to reduce the expenditure on account of telephone bills, the State Government has, in consultation with the BSNL authorities, to create a Combined User Group (CUG) / Virtual Private Network (VPN) for landline and mobile phones taken from BSNL by Haryana Government Departments, Boards, Corporations and other statutory bodies installed all over the State including Panchkula and Chandigarh. The CUG / VPN would not include the mobile phones taken from MTNL in Gurgaon and Faridabad.

2. The tariff plan for various types of services for the above mentioned CUG / VPN is attached as Anenxure-1. It may be noted that the calls within the above mentioned CUG / VPN of landline and mobile phones shall be free of cost. Further, the family members (husband, wife and dependent children), who have obtained private connections from BSNL, can also be included in the combined VPN. However, the calls made outside the CUG/VPN shall be chargeable as per the tariff plan. As mentioned in para 1 above, the mobile phones in Faridabad and

Faridabad and Gurgaon region shall not be the part of the CUG / VPN and shall be charged as calls made outside the CUG/VPN.

3. On receipt of list of telephone numbers, both landlines and mobile, from the Govt. of Haryana, the BSNL will configure virtual private network (VPN) and set-up CUG. In this regard, the following decisions have been taken:-

- a) Head of the Departments / Managing Directors / Chief Executive Officers / Divisional Commissioners / Registrars of all Govt. Department / Boards / Corporations shall ensure that lists of telephone with respect to their departments / organizations, including their field offices, are provided in the proforma attached as Annexure-2 to the Nodal Officers of BSNL. A copy of the Nodal Officers of BSNL is attached as Annexure-3. Lists of phone installed at Panchkula and Chandigarh would be provided to Nodal Officer of BSNL located at Chandigarh.
- b) In respect of the telephones taken on Secretariat side, the list would be supplied by the Secretariat Establishment and that of New Secretariat (FCR's Office) by Joint Secretary / Special Secretary, Revenue.
- c) A copy each of the combined list of all phones numbers of your department / organization should also be sent to Joint Secretary, Secretariat Establishment, Office of Chief Secretary, Govt. of Haryana, Chandigarh and to Manager (IT), Department of Information Technology, Govt. of Haryana, Chandigarh.
- d) The lists should be furnished to all concerned by 22/06/2009.
- e) In future, any new landline or mobile telephone connection that your organization obtains from BSNL should also be got included in the CUG / VPN.
- f) The VPN is likely to come into operation by 01/07/2009. Any change in this regard would be intimated to you.
