Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to Commission's letter No. 437/6/ECI/INST/FUNCT/MCC/2019, dated 21<sup>st</sup> September, 2019 and to state that the provisions of Model Code of Conduct are

enforced from the date of announcement of election schedule by the Election Commission and it remains in operation till completion of election process.

Now, that the declaration of result in respect of General Elections to the State Legislative Assemblies of Haryana and Maharashtra and Bye-elections to various Parliamentary Constituencies and State Legislative Assemblies of various States and UTs have been completed, the Model Code of Conduct in effect since 21<sup>st</sup> September, 2019 has ceased to be in operation in the States of Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Meghalaya, Odisha, Puducherry, Punjab, Rajasthan, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, and Uttar Pradesh, with immediate effect.
