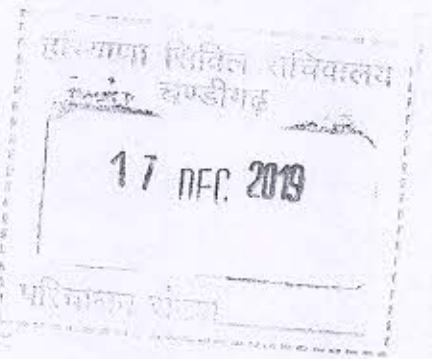

Sub:- Filling up of the post of Junior Scientific Officer (Drugs) Group "B" Gazetted in Directorate of Food and Drugs Administration, Government of Goa, Bambolim-Goa on deputation.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to address you on the subject cited above and to state that this department has decided to fill up one (01) post of **Junior Scientific Officer (Drugs) (Group "B" Gazetted)**, Level 7, Pay Band 2 Rs.9300-34800+ Grade Pay Rs.4600/- pre-revised in Directorate of Food and Drugs Administration, Bambolim-Goa by transfer on deputation basis from the Officers under Central/State Government/Union Territories.

As per Recruitment Rules for the above post, Officers under the Central/State Government/Union Territories holding analogous posts are eligible for appointment by transfer on deputation, as under:-

(i) Holding analogous post on regular basis.

Or

(ii) With 5 years regular service in the post of Chemist (Drugs) in the scale of Rs.5500-9000/- and above possessing educational qualifications and experience prescribed for direct recruits.

A copy of R.R's wherein the essential qualification for the post of Junior Scientific Officer (Drugs) is enclosed herewith for perusal.

The period of deputation shall ordinarily not exceed 3 years and the pay and allowances on deputation will be fixed as per the existing rules of the Government.

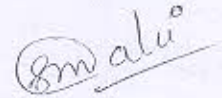

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, and in supersession of the existing Recruitment Rules for the relevant posts, the Governor of Goa hereby makes the following rules to regulate the recruitment to the Goa General Service, Group 'B' Gazetted posts in the Directorate of Food and Drugs Administration, Government of Goa, namely:—

1. *Short title, application and commencement.*—

(1) These rules may be called the Government of Goa, Directorate of Food and Drugs Administration, Group 'B', Gazetted posts, Recruitment Rules, 2007.

(2) They shall apply to the posts specified in column (2) of the Schedule to these rules (hereinafter called as the "said Schedule").

(3) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Number, classification and scales of pay.*—

The number of posts, classification of the said posts and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (3) to (5) of the said Schedule:

Provided that the Government may vary the number of posts in column (3) of the said Schedule from time to time subject to exigencies of work.

3. *Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.*—

The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns (6) to (14) of the said Schedule.

4. *Disqualification.*— No person who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living or who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the service:

Provided that the Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. *Power to relax.*— Where, the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Goa Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. *Saving.*— Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for Scheduled Castes, and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in that regard.

7. These rules are issued in consultation with the Goa Public Service Commission vide their letter No.COM/II/13/56(1)/92/475 dated 9-4-2007, and No. COM/II/13/56(2)/92/448 dated 2-4-2007.

(ii) Knowledge of Konkani.

Note: In case of non-availability of a suitable candidate with the knowledge of Konkani, this requirement can be relaxed.
