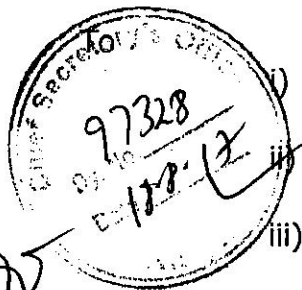

With the approval of H.E. the Administrator, Union Territory, Chandigarh, it has been decided by the Chandigarh Administration that the Chairperson/ President/ Members of various Commissions/ Tribunals, Forums etc. set up by the Punjab Government/ Haryana Government as well as Chandigarh Administration, in occupation of the houses of Chandigarh Administration General Pool shall vacate the Govt. houses within one month from the date of completion of their tenure as such or as and when they demit the post held by them. In case of non vacation of Govt. house within one month, the allotment of Govt. house shall be cancelled after the expiry of one month and penal rent shall be charged.

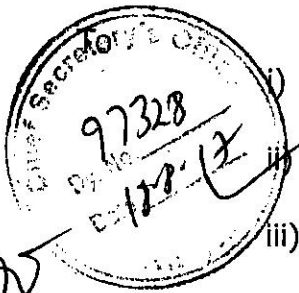
