Subject:- The All India Services (PAR) Rules, 2007- annual medical checkup for IAS officers.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to invite a reference to the Government letter No.30/13/2003-S(I) dated 01-05-2009 on the subject mentioned above and to say that the Government of India vide its notification No. 11059/03/2012-AISIII, dated 19.02.2013 has revised proforma for annual health check-up of IAS officers which was circulated amongst the IAS officers vide letter No. 30/13/2003-3S(I), dated 11-3-2013. The Government of India vide its letter No. 11059/03/2012-AISIII, dated 20-2-2013 also informed that Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has approved the revised rates for health check-up i.e. Rs.2000/- for men and Rs.2200/- for women in respect of AIS officers.

2. The IAS officers working at Chandigarh/Panchkula have the option to get their medical tests carried out either at the Private Hospitals and seek the medical reimbursement or at the General Hospital, Sector-6, Panchkula or at the Haryana MLAs Hostel Dispensary, Chandigarh. The expenditure incurred by the General Hospital, Sector-6, Panchkula or the MLAs Hostel Dispensary Chandigarh on conducting the tests (through own/private labs) would be reimbursed to the Hospital/Dispensary by the Health Department, subsequently, in consultation with the Finance Department. The officers are not required to pay anything to the General Hospital, Sector-6, Panchkula or the MLAs Hostel Dispensary, Chandigarh in this regard.

3. The IAS officers also have the option to get the requisite medical tests done at the General Hospital, Sector-16, Chandigarh. If any of the prescribed tests have to be got conducted from private labs due to non availability of the facility in General Hospital, Sector-16, Chandigarh, the same would be reimbursable subject to a maximum amount of Rs.2000/- for men and Rs.2200/- for women.

4. For IAS officers working in the field, they can get the medical tests done at the nearest Government Hospital where such facilities exist. For such tests which are not available at the Government Hospitals, the actual expenditure incurred by the officers for getting these tests done through private hospitals/laboratories shall be reimbursable, as per actual, subject to the condition that the overall expenditure on medical tests for the purpose of PAR, does not exceed Rs.2000/- for men and Rs.2200/- for women.

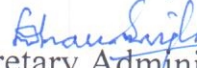

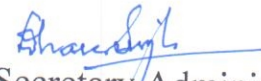

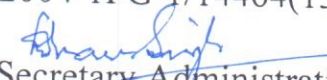
