The undersigned is directed to state that the Defence Service Staff College (DSSC), Wellington will be conducting 74th Staff Course of 45 weeks duration (which does not include the Orientation Capsule which is of two weeks) for officers of the three Defence Services of the rank of Captains/Majors in the Army and their equivalent in other services. The course lays stress on issues relating to Inter-Services cooperation and planning. The aim of the course is to bring them at par with the Service officers and to familiarize them with the functioning of DSSC, Wellington.

2. The 74th Staff Course is scheduled to commence from 11th June, 2018 to 20th April, 2019. Four vacancies are earmarked in this course for Group 'A' Officers of Central Civil Services. The selected Officers will be required to undergo an Orientation Course of 02 weeks commencing from 28th May, 2018 to 09th June, 2018. Dates of reporting for the Orientation Course (for foreign and Civilian Officers) and the main course at DSSC are 21st May, 2018. Per capita cost of training for this course will be applicable as per rates existing at present. Only those officers should be sponsored who can be assuredly released from May, 2018 till April, 2019 for attending the course, if selected.

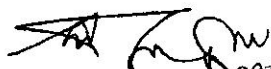
Subject- **Allotment of Vacancies for the 74th Staff Course at DSSC, Wellington**

The course lays stress on issues relating to Inter-Services co-operation and planning. The aim of the course is to bring them at par with the Service officers and to familiarize them with the functioning of DSSC, Wellington.

2. The 74th Staff Course is scheduled to commence from 11th June, 2018 to 20th April, 2019. Four vacancies are earmarked in this course for **Group 'A' Officers of Central Civil Services**. The selected Officers will be required to undergo an Orientation Course of 02 weeks commencing from **28th May, 2018 to 09th June, 2018**. Dates of reporting for the Orientation Course (for Foreign and Civilian Officers) and the Main Course at DSSC are **21st May, 2018**. Per capita cost of training for this course will be applicable as per rates existing at present.
