Subject:- Investigation of CBI Case No.RC1202018A0006 and RC0062018A0007- Fake educational board in the name of "Board of Secondary education, Madhya Bharat, Gwalior" regarding

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to invite your attention to the subject noted above and to inform that the Central Bureau of Investigation, Anti-Corruption Branch, Dehradun has registered two criminal cases against a fake educational board in the name and style of "Board of Secondary Education, Madhya Bharat, Gwalior." The instant board had issued a large number of fake mark sheets and certificates with/without conducting examinations and solely for the purpose of financial gains.

2. All the boards which were functional prior to independence became invalid and cease to exist after the establishment of Central Board of Secondary Education in the year 1952. But the name of some educational boards including Board of Secondary Education, Madhya Pradesh, Gwalior, inadvertently remained mentioned in the Uttar Pradesh Intermediate Education Act, 1921. Taking advantage of this fact, the accused persons have re-established this board by way of Registered Trust Deeds in the year 2010-11 and still continuing its operations all over the country.

3. The Ministry of Human Resource Development, New Delhi, Education Departments of Government of Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh have neither approved nor recognized any board in the name of Board of Secondary Education, Madhya Bharat, Gwalior. The issuance of mark sheets and certificates by this board is completely illegal as an Educational Board which is constituted as per Statute can only issue mark sheets and certificates.

4. During the enquiry by Central Bureau of Investigation, Anti-Corruption Branch, Dehradun it has been revealed that various States of Republic of India have given equivalence to the examinations of "Board of Secondary Education, Madhya Bharat, Gwalior" in their respective states for the purpose of seeking appointment in different

Government/Private Organizations and for taking admissions for higher studies. Further, various schools/colleges of these States have also taken affiliation from "Board of Secondary Education, Madhya Bharat, Gwalior" to conduct examinations of Class- 10th and 12th and are issuing mark sheets and certificates of this board to the candidates. On the basis of these fake mark sheets and certificates, various candidates have procured appointments in Government Departments of Union of India as well as States.

5. The matter has been considered by the State Government and accordingly, it is requested to verify the marksheets and certificates of the all the employees and if someone found who have procured appointment in the Haryana State on the basis of marksheet and certificate of "Board of Secondary Education, Madhya Bharat, Gwalior", his appointment may be cancelled with immediate effect and suitable action as deemed fit may be taken against him and action taken report may be sent to this office.

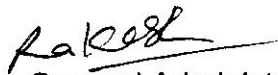
