Subject:- Case No. 6197/7/4/2014/UC-compliance of the directions issued by the National Human Right Commission (NHRC) regarding.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to invite your attention to the subject noted above and to inform that the National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) has brought to the notice of the State Government that they had taken Suo-Motu notice of a newspaper item that a poor woman was forced to deliver a baby on the road, outside the delivery hut of the PHC at Kulan in Fatehabad. This was highly insensitive and NHRC had directed the DG, Health Services, Haryana to get the matter inquired by some senior officer of another district. However, the health department got the enquiry conducted by CMO, Fatehabad itself, which was objectionable since NHRC had directed that matter be inquired by senior officer of another district/zone. Therefore, the Commission has taken serious note of the non-adherence to the directions of the Commission.

2. The matter has been considered by the State Government and it has been decided that the directions issued by the National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) should be followed by the departments meticulously and reports be submitted to the Commission within the time allowed.

3. These instructions may be brought to the notice of all concerned for strict compliance.
