Subject: Providing of wages during the period of lockdown under Outsourcing Policy Part-I or directly engaged under Outsourcing Policy Part-II or through HARTRON or any other outsourcing mechanism.

Sir/Madam,

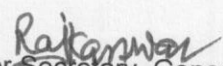
I am directed to invite your attention to Finance Department Memo No.25/3/2020-3B&C dated 25.03.2020, in which it was ensured by Government that all contractual workers will receive wages even if they were unable to perform their work during the period of Lockdown.

2. All of us are aware that due to spread of Novel Coronavirus (Covid-19) complete lockdown was implemented in the country during the months of March-April, 2020. During this period, to assist various sections that are adversely affected by the lockdown and to mitigate their economic hardship in the short run, Government has taken decision that all the Departments which have engaged workers through Service Providers under Outsourcing Policy Part-I or directly engaged persons under Outsourcing Policy Part-II or engaged through HARTRON or any other outsourcing mechanism shall be paid wages during the period of Lockdown even if no attendance has been recorded or no work has been performed by them provided the same would have otherwise been admissible to them. All the Heads of Departments/Appointing Authorities are requested to clarify by 31st of October, 2020 positively whether for the period of March-April, 2020 the wages have been paid to the—

- (i) workers, engaged under Outsourcing Policy Part-I, by the Service Provider concerned;
- (ii) persons engaged under Outsourcing Policy Part-II; and
- (iii) persons engaged through HARTRON.

3. If the wages have not been paid to the persons engaged under Outsourcing Policy Part-II or through HARTRON the same should be done within seven working days of the receipt of this letter. In case of workers engaged by the Service Provider under Part-I of the Policy, the Provider shall be directed to pay full monthly wages to the persons engaged for the month of March and April, 2020.
