**Subject: Raising the upper age limit for entry into Haryana Government service-
Amendment in relevant Service Rules.**

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to invite your attention to the subject noted above and to say that Government had issued instruction bearing No. 03/05/2014-4GSIII, dated 26-8-2014 and No. 22/06/2021-1GS-III, dated 03-02-2021 regarding raising upper age limit for entry into government service to 42 years. It was specified in the instructions that immediate compliance shall be done by all the departments and amendment in the relevant service rules, wherever considered necessary. All the Administrative Secretaries/Head of Departments/Board/ Corporations were also advised vide instructions dated 10-07-2015, 04/05-12-2017 & 11-06-2018 to ensure immediate compliance and amendment in the relevant service rules.

2. It has come to notice of Govt. that some departments have still not complied with the above mentioned govt. instructions and service rules have not been amended till date in respect of age of entry into Govt. Service.

3. A meeting is proposed to be held to ascertain compliance of these instructions by the various departments on dated **16th March, 2022 at 3.00 PM** under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary to Government Haryana, at the Main Committee Room, 4th Floor, Haryana Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh.

5. You are further requested to bring copies of notification of amendments in Group A, B, C & D service rules regarding upper age limit of 42 years in the said meeting.
