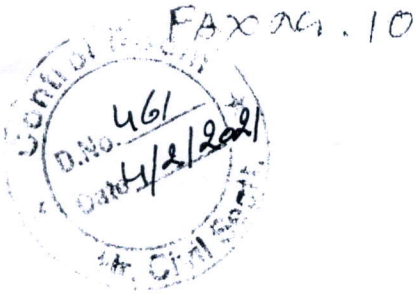

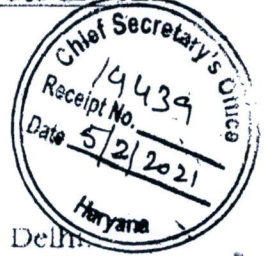

As per reports received, leaders of various farmers' organisations have announced a three hour (1200-1500) nationwide 'Chakka Jam' programme on February 6, 2021. It has also been reported that as part of the proposed programme, protesting farmer unions may attempt road blockades of important National Highways, State Highways and other arterial roads, apart from which, activists might also attempt 'Rail Roko' in some areas.
