- (a) Reading out the Preamble to Constitution (as it exists today) in all Educational Institutions and Government offices.
- (b) Mock Parliament may be organized. (in Higher Education institutions like Schools/Colleges/ Law Colleges/Universities (at least one per district).
- (c) Essay writing/debate competitions and lectures may be organized in Schools/ Colleges/ Universities.

The Departments & Districts may identify more activities to celebrate Constitution Day this year in order to create awareness among people about the Constitution of India.

THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA

PREAMBLE

WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a ³[SOVEREIGN SOCIALIST SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC and to secure to all its citizens:

JUSTICE, social, economic and political;

LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship;

EQUALITY of status and of opportunity;

and to promote among them all

FRATERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and the ⁴[unity and integrity of the Nation;

IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY this twenty-sixth day of November, 1949, do HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION.
