**APPOINTMENT OF CHIEF COMMISSIONER AND COMMISSIONERS
IN HARYANA RIGHT TO SERVICE COMMISSION**

Haryana Government intends to constitute the Haryana Right to Service Commission in accordance with the provisions contained in the Haryana Right to Service Ordinance, 2013 and to appoint a Chief Commissioner and two Commissioners in the said Commission for the time being. Persons of eminence having the requisite qualifications and fulfilling criteria for appointment as Chief Commissioner and Commissioner, as the case may be, and interested in appointment as such, may send in their particulars in the proforma appended with detailed instructions available on the website (<http://csharyana.gov.in>). Applications complete in all regards may be sent to the office of Secretary to Government, Haryana, Administrative Reforms Department in the Room No. 525, 5th Floor, New Civil Secretariat Building, Haryana, Sector 17, Chandigarh on any working day and latest by 27th January, 2014 upto 1700 hours.

**Appointment of Chief Commissioner and Commissioners
in the Haryana Right to Service Commission.**

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The Government of Haryana intends to constitute a body under the Haryana Right to Service Ordinance, 2013 to be known as the 'Haryana Right to Service Commission, to exercise the powers conferred on and to perform the functions assigned to it under this Ordinance. It will be located at Chandigarh. The Commission shall have a Chief Commissioner and upto four Commissioners. The powers and functions of the Chief Commissioner and Commissioners in the Commission will be as per Section 14 of the Ordinance.

2. It has been decided that one Chief Commissioner and two Commissioners in the Commission be appointed, for the time being. Section 13(2) of the Ordinance provides that the Chief Commissioner shall be a retired officer in the rank and status of the Chief Secretary of the State of Haryana or Secretary to the Government of India. Section 13(3) of the Ordinance provides that atleast two of the Commissioners shall be retired officers of the Government of Haryana in the rank and status of a Administrative Secretary or its equivalent rank and status in any of the services of the State, including officers of All India Services from the Haryana cadre and other commissioners can be persons of eminence in public life with atleast twenty years experience in management, law, administration or corporate governance.

3. The Chief Commissioner or Commissioners shall hold office for a term of five years from the date on which they enter upon the respective offices or until they attain the age of sixty five years, whichever is earlier and they shall not be entitled for re-appointment. The salary and allowances payable to and other terms and conditions of service of the Chief Commissioner and the Commissioners shall be the same as those of the State Chief Information Commissioner and the State Information Commissioners,

respectively as laid down in sub-section (5) of the Section 16 of the Right to Information Act, 2005.

4. Government has constituted a Search Committee to search and recommend the suitable candidates to the Statutory Committee to be constituted under sub-section (1) of section 13 of the Haryana Right to Service Ordinance, 2013 for appointment of Chief Commissioner/ Commissioner(s) pertaining to the Haryana Right to Service Commission.

5. It is made clear that while applying for the post of Chief Commissioner/Commissioner, the applicant must indicate:-

- i) Whether any criminal case has been registered against him/her ?
If yes, details thereof.
- ii) Whether the applicant has been charge-sheeted for any criminal offence ?
If yes, details thereof.
- iii) Whether the applicant has been convicted by any competent court for any criminal offence ?
If yes, details thereof.

6. Persons fulfilling the criteria for appointment as Chief Commissioner and Commissioner and interested for appointment to the post, may send their particulars in the proforma appended to these instructions, to the office of Secretary to Government of Haryana, Administrative Reforms Department, 5th Floor, Room No. 525, New Civil Secretariat Building, Haryana, Sector 17, Chandigarh by 27th January, 2014 upto 1700 hours. Persons who are serving under the State/Central Government or any other Organization, may send their particulars through proper channel.
