Policy for allowing the retention of official
residential telephone to officers on their
retirement.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to Govt. letter No.
12/117/82-3PS dated 27th June, 1983 on the subject noted above
and to state that the matter regarding extension of the period
of retention of the official residential telephone by an
officer on his retirement/transfer has been reconsidered by
the Govt. and after careful consideration, it has been decided
that when an officer having a telephone at his residence
retires, the period for which he may be allowed to retain
the official telephone after retirement should be co-terminus
with the period for which he is allowed to retain Govt. residence
on the normal rate as per F.D. circular letter No. 10/14/94-2FICW
dated 20th Jan. 1985. This period is for four months. In the
case of transfer 2 months in normal circumstances. Additional
2 months on medical grounds of self or members of family or, on
grounds of education of children of the employees subject to
the approval of competent authority.

All other instructions issued in this behalf will
