Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention on the subject cited above and to say that the Government attaches great importance in providing clean administration to the public. In order to eradicate corruption, it is suggested that importance of preventive vigilance may be adequately taken care of various rules and regulations, particularly those that effect the common people may be examined so as to consider the scope for simplification of procedures with a view to minimising scope for corruption. These steps may also have to be coordinated with proper selection of staff to be posted in identified corruption prone areas.

2. You are, therefore, requested to take necessary action accordingly.
