I am directed to refer to this Department letter of even No. dated 15.3.89, on the subject noted above and to say that in the Administrative Secretaries meeting held on 6-2-89 under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary, it was again emphasised that for providing clean administration to the public the rules and procedures may be simplified with a view to minimise the scope of corruption and to avoid harassment. Steps taken in regard to simplify various rules and procedures pertaining to your department in the light of these instructions may kindly be intimated urgently so that the position can be reviewed in the next meeting of Administrative Secretaries.
